LED lighting offers many advantages over incandescent lighting and white-light LED lamps are now widely available. They offer lower energy consumption, greater durability, faster on-and-off switching, dimming capability - to name a few benefits.



Rebates of \$1 for each reduced-wattage T8 lamp, when you

re-lamp the entire building or an entire floor of a building

Even if you have already installed T8 lighting, you can reduce your energy costs by installing reduced-wattage T8 lamps in your building. These 25- or 28-watt T8 lamps are energy-saving options to traditional 32-watt T8 lamps.



Rebates of \$25 for qualified Ceramic Metal Halide (CMH) lamps

When you need bright and focused light for displays, performances or general illumination, CMH lamps are an energy-saving option for the replacement of incandescent flood lamps. They produce the same light but last five times longer.



No pre-approval is required for these rebates and eligibility restrictions apply. Customers must purchase electricity from PSE at the site where the replacement lighting is installed.
